How to Apply

REQUIREMENTS

- Must be considered to be a member of a racial or ethnic minority group.
- Must be enrolled in a college of agriculture, family & consumer sciences, education, or closely related field.
- Must have completed approximately 50% of required coursework for a Bachelor's degree with a cumulative GPA of 2.7 or higher, or must be a graduate student.
- Must have transportation to and from work.
- Interns must secure their own housing arrangements. The internship does not provide housing.

Deadline for best consideration is January 31, 2022.
