Volunteer Engagement!


- Extension professionals are volunteer administrators

- Volunteers are covered by State of Tennessee liability insurance
- "Are we covered by insurance?"
 Yes, because your volunteers
 are in a well-managed County
 SUPER database (Extension
 professionals already covered)
